Lake Report – We have a good lake crew and the majority has already started working, both on the lake and prairie. We are rebuilding the front end of a shore barge with stainless steel this time, testing if it will outlast regular steel.

Sewer Report- Sewer flows have been high and feel the source is due to Sump pumps draining into our system.

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Unfinished Business -

- Lake Management Plan by SEWRPC – T. Koepp reported that the Plan is in the process of being printed, but at this time have not received an update.

- PS # 3 & PS #7 have been completed.

- PS #2 & #4 work crews have already cut some trees down so that grading can start. Also, have the samples for siding & shingles.

- Pewaukee Lake Dam Order & Lake Levels – T. Koepp presented an electronic report of the Lake level from the Village of Pewaukee gauge that electronically measure levels and temperatures.

- T. Koepp reported on the status of the disability insurance applications at this time.

New Business- T. Koepp reported on the status at this time of the sewer relocation on the French properties. A final plan will need to be reviewed and documents signed prior to Commission approval.
